**NOTICE**

Based upon the investigation reports submitted by the District Attorneys' Offices of Bologna and Ravenna, the District Attorney's Office in charge of Anti-doping has summoned Dr. Michele Ferrari to appear before the FCI (*Italian Cycling Federation, N. of T.*) Disciplinary Commission. The investigation reports revealed sufficient evidence of Dr. Ferrari's involvement in doping-related activities. The FCI, on behalf of the ICU, enforces the sanctions provided in article 158 of the current ICU Anti-Doping Regulations and specifically forbids:

- Dr. Ferrari to become a member of any other national or international cycling Federation;
- Dr. Ferrari to take part in any race or sport event of any kind organized by the FCI or the ICU.
- all Federations, clubs, sport societies and any other individual associated with the ICU to use the services of Dr. Ferrari.
